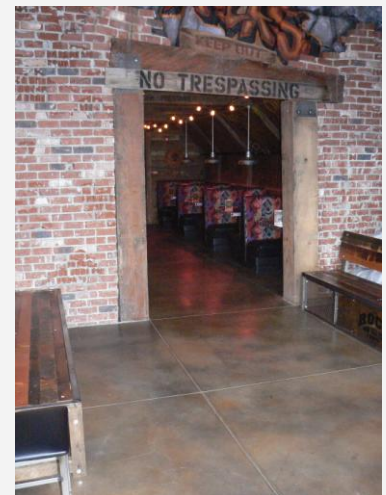

To accommodate this robust persona our crew used a blend of rich, deep colors, wood plank stamps, and a grid pattern. The black and brown stain with poly-urethane seal is great for the high traffic areas that need to look continuously

clean, and unworn. Wood plank stamps are a fun way to add character without adding maintenance. Consider this stain and stamp combination, or any combination, for your next project involving decorative finished concrete floors.
